Figure 1. Student and faculty mentor departmental breakdown (*Other category comprises < 2%)

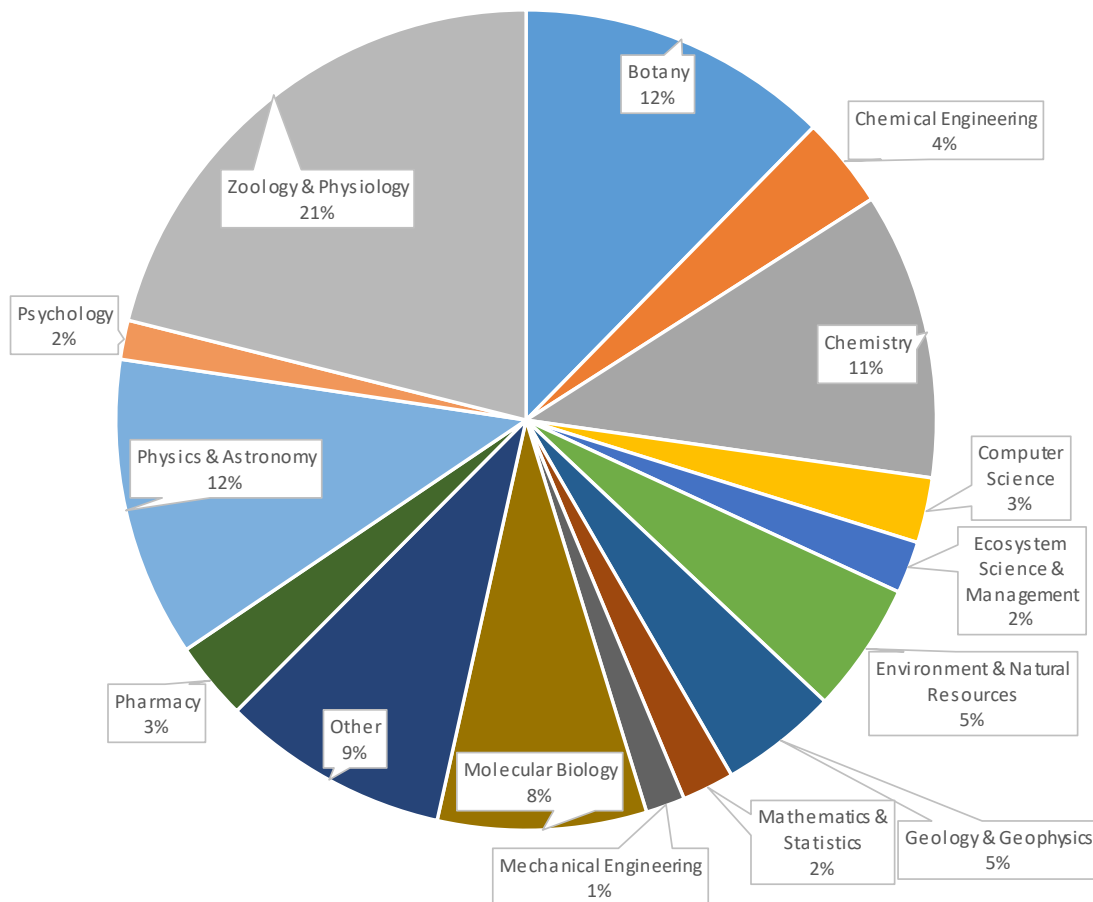
