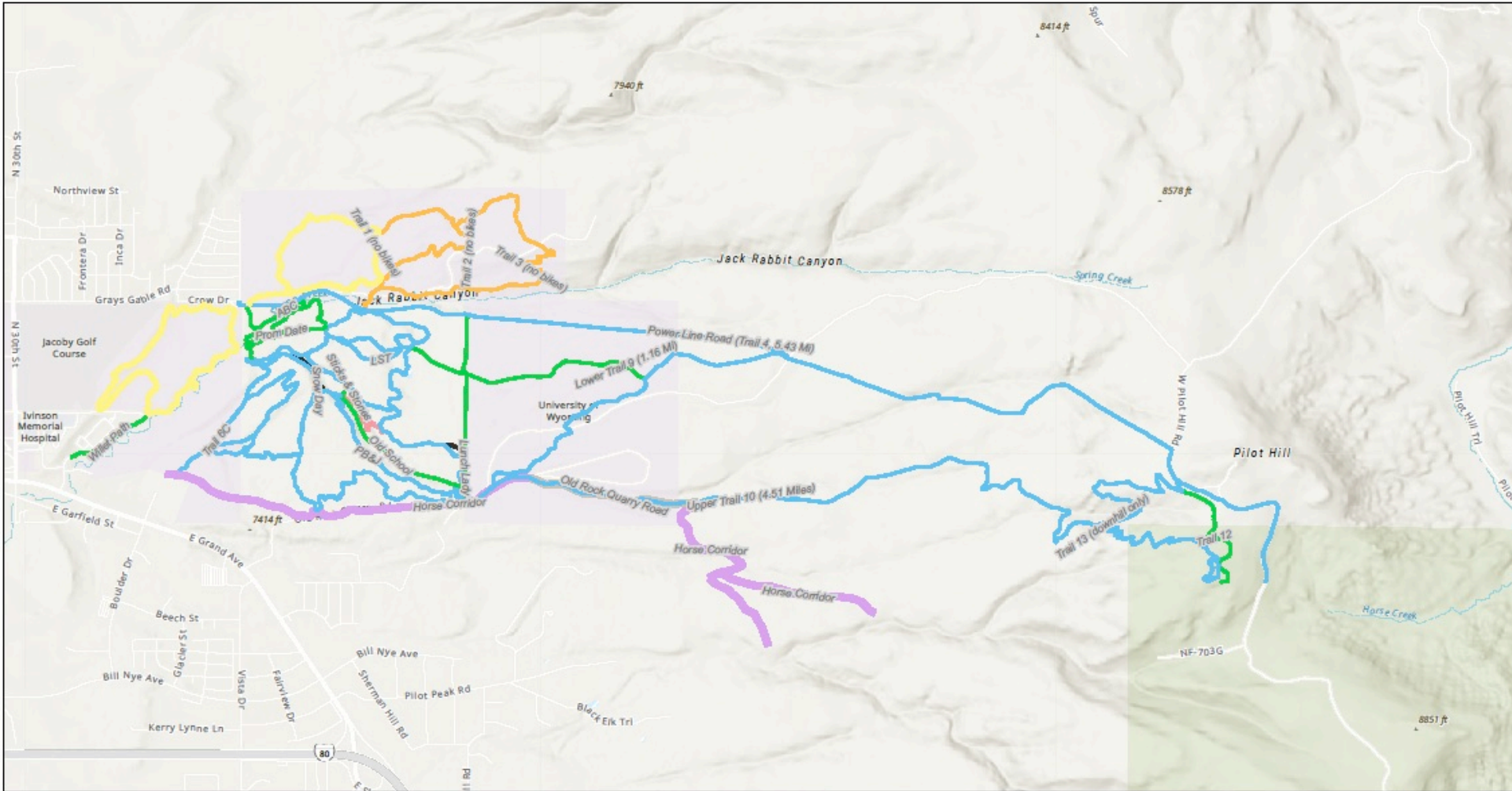

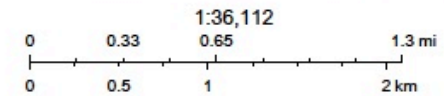
By the Numbers

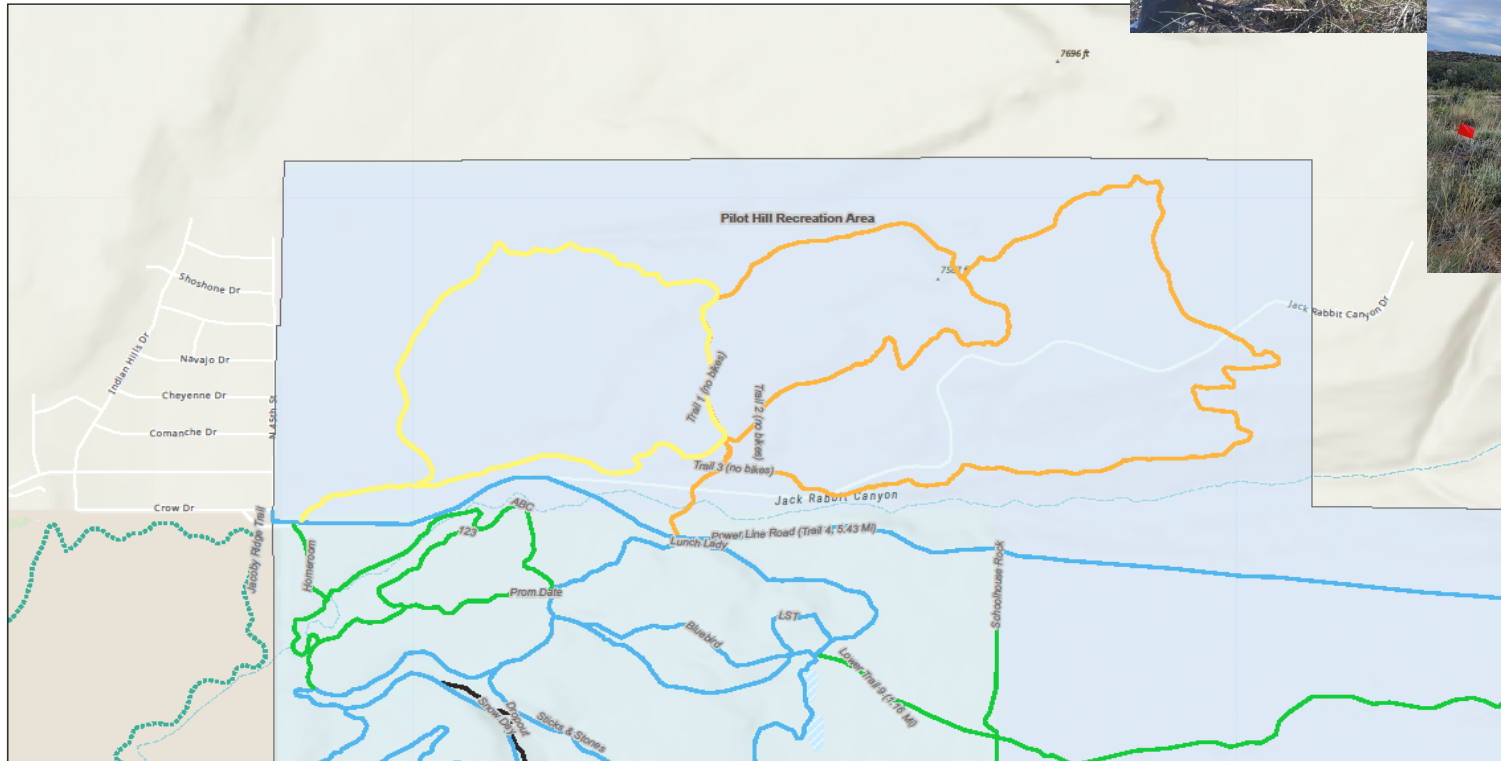

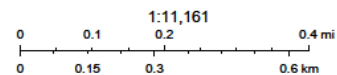
