Dr. Hardigan received his Bachelor of Science in Marketing from Ferris State University in 1987, his Master of Business Administration in Marketing from the University of Wyoming in 1991, and his Ph.D. in Cognitive Science from the University of Wyoming in 1996. Dr. Hardigan started his 27-year career in 1997 as Assistant Professor in UW's School of Pharmacy where he taught courses in marketing, management, and social/behavioral pharmacy. He became an Associate Professor/Director of the Testing Center from 1999-2001, then Associate Professor/Associate Dean in the College of Allied Health from 2001-2003, and then spent 17 years as a Professor of Public Health and the Executive Dean of Academic Affairs for Health Professions at Nova Southeastern University (NSU). Most recently, Dr. Hardigan acted as a Professor of Population Health, a Senior Associate Dean of Research for the College of Allopathic Medicine, and the Director for the Cell Therapy Institute for NSU, since 2020. He is also the founder and director of NSU's Statistical Consulting Center.
