Following an extended discussion, Mr. McCraken made a motion that	
George Duke Humphrey, President of Mississippi State College, be elected	President
President of the University of Wyoming. This motion was seconded by Mr.	Dr. Geo.D. Humphrey
Keeney and carried by a roll call vote in accordance with the by-laws.	
Mr. Keeney then moved that President Humphrey be offered a contract	
for three years with a salary of \$10,500 per year with other emoluments,	
the same as those now being received by President Morrill. The effective	
date of this contract to be not later than January 1, 1946. President	
Simpson is requested to call President Humphrey by telephone and get his	
acceptance of this proposal and ascertain the date when he would report	
for duty at the University of Wyoming. This motion was seconded by Mr.	
Burwell and carried.
