EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Academic Affairs is providing draft academic calendars for AY 27/28 to AY 29/30 for review by the AA/SA Committee. Final academic calendars will be submitted to the full Board of Trustees at their May 2026 meeting for approval.

Interim Provost Alexander charged the calendar committee with developing an academic calendar that includes a week break for students over Thanksgiving. This would require the University to start classes one week earlier in the Fall semester to meet the 15-week semester requirement. We collected schedules from regional and comparator schools for their schedules as consideration. We have provided the AA/SA committee with two calendars for each academic year; one with a traditional schedule and the second with Thanksgiving week off.

The academic calendar has been reviewed by representatives from across UW and other related agencies, including: ASUW, Staff Senate, Faculty Senate, OTR, Athletics, ACSD #1, Financial Services, Scholarships and Financial Aid, Human Resources, RLDS and Union, Alumni Association, College of Law, College of Business, LCCC, Graduate Education, Admissions, Student Success and Graduation, Online Education, and Academic Affairs. We have collected feedback from constituents on calendar principles. Based on their feedback, the draft calendars were assembled and reviewed for AY 27/28 to AY 29/30.

## University of Wyoming Academic Calendar Principles Charter

### Purpose

The academic calendar is a central feature of the University's mission, shaping student success, faculty productivity, and alignment with our community. These principles should guide the Academic Calendar Committee in developing multi-year calendars that meet accreditation requirements, support student and faculty needs, and harmonize with our partners.

---

#### 1. Instructional Integrity

- Each semester shall include a **minimum of 70 instructional days** and normally **15 instructional weeks**, with at least 14 instructional days for each weekday.
  - A **5-day final examination period** shall conclude each semester. The week prior to the final examination week shall be Reading Week, in line with UW Regulations and policies.
  - The calendar must comply with Carnegie credit hour standards and accreditation requirements.
- 

#### 2. Student Success and Well-Being

- Consider recommending that the **entire week of Thanksgiving** be observed as a class break.
  - **Spring Break** shall be aligned with Albany County School District #1 whenever possible.
  - A **Winter Break of at least three full weeks** shall be scheduled between fall and spring semesters, inclusive of a **January Term (J-term)** for intensive learning, study abroad, or internships.
  - Each semester may include one additional **"mini-break" day** (Monday or Friday preferred).

#### 3. Harmonization with Educational Partners

- The calendar shall be developed in consultation with **Albany County School District #1** to align key breaks.
  - The University shall work toward a **common academic calendar** with Wyoming's community colleges, especially Laramie County Community College (Albany County Campus) and Casper College (due to UW-Casper's collocation on their campus).
- 

#### 4. Predictable Structure

- **Fall Semester** shall begin on a Monday, ideally **two Mondays before Labor Day**.
  - **Spring Semester** shall begin on the Tuesday following **MLK/Equality Day**; if this is not possible, disruption of the cadence of the spring due to that holiday should be minimized.
  - There should be at least **two full instructional weeks after Thanksgiving Break** before the start of finals if possible.
  - Finals Week shall run **Monday through Friday without interruption**.
- 

#### 5. Faculty and Staff Considerations

- Academic schedules shall support **faculty teaching and research productivity**, including January Term opportunities.
  - Staff shall benefit from reasonable time off during extended breaks (e.g., Thanksgiving).
  - Energy conservation and efficient use of facilities shall be considered when designing extended breaks.
- 

#### 6. Flexibility and Innovation

- A **3-week January Term (J-term)** shall be preserved to support study abroad, internships, and intensive learning.
- Summer scheduling should allow for **modular instructional options** (e.g., overlapping six-week terms) to expand course offerings.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Over the past five years, the University of Wyoming (UW) has strategically launched new degree programs and certificates aligned with workforce needs, student demand, and our land-grant mission. The attached report, *New Programs in 5 Years Enrollment Combined*, reflects enrollment trends for programs initiated between Fall 2021 and Fall 2025.

Across colleges, newly established programs demonstrate both early adoption and sustained growth, particularly in agriculture, health sciences, computing, engineering, education, energy, and leadership. Several undergraduate programs in Ranch Management & Agricultural Leadership, Human Nutrition & Food, Plant Production & Protection, and the Creative Arts have shown measurable increases over multiple fall terms. Graduate offerings in Mathematics Education, Literacy Education, and Artificial Intelligence similarly reflect growing interest and responsiveness to workforce and state priorities. Certificate programs in areas such as public health, land administration, leadership, and energy continue to provide flexible, workforce-aligned pathways that complement degree offerings.

UW uses Fall Day 15 data as our official census for reporting enrollment data. We use federally reported data as our official numbers to ensure consistency across all our public reporting. Using a defined census each year facilitates consistent trend reporting from year to year. Data does change throughout the semester/year, but we utilize data that's frozen in an auditable format. This methodology ensures transparency, comparability, and compliance with federal reporting standards.

Programs are listed as “new” in this report at the time they are formally approved by the Board of Trustees. As a result, it is common to see a “0” enrollment in the first year a program appears. This does not necessarily reflect a lack of interest; rather, it often reflects timing considerations in the implementation process.

In some cases, enrollment may be delayed due to required approval processes through the Higher Learning Commission. In other instances, programs are approved mid-cycle, and additional time is needed for marketing, recruitment, and communication so that Admissions, Advising, and prospective students are fully aware of the new offering. These operational realities can create a one to two-year lag between Board approval and visible enrollment growth.

Conversely, some programs demonstrate a quicker trajectory to enrollment. This often occurs when a program represents a name change, consolidation, or restructuring of an existing academic offering, sometimes due to external accreditation requirements or strategic alignment. In those cases, students may transition into the newly approved degree structure more quickly, resulting in stronger early enrollment numbers. Understanding these contextual factors is important when reviewing the data across the five-year period.

Overall, the enrollment patterns in degrees and certificates approved within the last five years reflect a thoughtful expansion of academic offerings aligned with state needs, workforce demand, accreditation standards, and institutional strategy. While implementation timelines vary, the data demonstrate steady development and growing student interest across multiple colleges. These programs strengthen the University of Wyoming's academic portfolio and reinforce our commitment to innovation, responsiveness, and service to the state.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Provost invites discussion with the Academic and Student Affairs Committee regarding implications of the 2026 legislative session for the University of Wyoming's academic enterprise. The biennial budget approved by the Wyoming Legislature keeps UW's state block grant at the governor's recommended level and includes funding for employee pay raises as well as targeted investments supporting various university priorities, such as student internships, agriculture initiatives, career and technical education facilities, and other workforce-related programs.

The legislation also requires the university to conduct a thorough review of its organizational structure and staffing across all divisions, colleges, administrative units, auxiliaries, and support functions. This review aims to identify opportunities to improve institutional efficiency, including consolidating or restructuring administrative and academic operations where appropriate. Additionally, the legislation calls for creating an inventory of academic degree programs, considering course participation and recent graduate numbers, to identify potential opportunities for program consolidation or elimination.

The university is required to submit a report summarizing the review results to the Governor and the Legislature by December 1, 2026. The Provost welcomes the opportunity to discuss with AA/SA Trustees how Academic and Student Affairs can thoughtfully address this directive while continuing to support the university's academic mission, student success, and service to the state of Wyoming.




# First-time, Full-time Student Retention:




# First-time, Full-time Fall-to-Spring Retention





Admissions Category






