

LARAMIE AREA AMATEUR RADIO NET PREAMBLE

QST, QST, QST, This is **YOUR CALLSIGN**, name here is **YOUR NAME**, calling the Laramie Area Amateur Radio Net.

This is a directed roll call net, please address all comments to the net control. All amateurs in Albany and surrounding counties are invited to participate.

This net facilitates the coordination of activities and topics for the AMATEUR RADIO EMERGENCY SERVICE (ARES), for the RADIO AMATEUR CIVIL EMERGENCY SERVICE (RACES), and for the UNIVERSITY AMATEUR RADIO CLUB (UARC).

This net meets at 6:15 pm local time each Sunday. On the first Sunday of each month the net meets on the Jelm repeater at a frequency of 147.015 Megahertz, On the rest of the Sundays it meets on the UARC repeater at a frequency of 146.610 Megahertz. Both repeaters utilize a standard offset for frequency range and require a tone of 146.2 Hertz. In the event of a repeater failure the net will meet on the other repeater.
