
General Parking & Transportation for Events in the Arts & Sciences Auditorium at the University of Wyoming

Parking Information

Normal parking enforcement is Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. The parking lot located at 11th & Ivinson is most easily available for A&S event parking. S Accessible parking spaces for individuals with disabilities are located at 10th & Lewis, Aven Nelson, Merica Hall, and 11th & Ivinson.

If your event occurs outside normal enforcement hours, you may park in several spaces without paying for parking. Please note that parking is enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week in yellow zones, fire lanes, a accessible spaces, "U" spaces, reserved spaces, "R" spaces, loading/unloading zones, motorcycle parking, and no parking areas. Metered parking and "A" parking around the residence halls and Greek houses are also enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

If your event occurs during normal enforcement hours, please be sure to purchase a day permit, use the meters or Day Lot, or use the FREE parking located at one of the Express Shuttle lots. Additional parking information can be found online at <u>www.uwyo.edu/tps</u>.



Transportation Information

Transit & Parking Services does not offer a mass shuttle directly to the A&S building (unless a charter has been organized). All individuals are welcome to use the <u>UWYO Roundup Transit System</u>. Please keep the time of the event in mind when planning your trip. All general shuttles end at 6:30 pm.

Union & South Express: Plenty of parking is available at the remote lots located between 22nd & 30th Street on Willett Drive and at 15th Street and Spring Creek. A Union/South Express bus arrives every 6 to 8 minutes. It is a short trip directly to the Wyoming Union. The Union and South Express operate from 7:00 am to 6:30 pm (6:00 pm during the summer), Monday through Friday. Additional shuttles are also available. Accessible Transportation: Individuals that may need additional help with accessible transportation, should contact the <u>UW paratransit service</u> at (307) 766-6686 for more information. The UW paratransit service operates from 6:30 am to 6:30 pm, Monday through Friday. Rides must be scheduled at least one day in advance.
