CALSNR Ambassador Definition

The College Ambassadors are a select group of students in the College of Agriculture, Life Sciences and Natural Resources (CALSNR) volunteering to assist the college in recruiting, promoting, and clientele relation activities, serving at the pleasure of the Dean.

Membership Requirements

- The student's declared primary major must be in the College of Agriculture, Life Sciences and Natural Resources (students with concurrent majors are eligible).
- The student must be a full-time student as defined by the University of Wyoming and have attended the College of Agriculture, Life Sciences and Natural Resources for at least one full semester. Freshman and transfer students may apply for membership during their first and subsequent semesters but may not serve until their second semester or later.
- Undergraduate students must have and maintain a minimum 2.50 cumulative GPA, Graduate students must have and maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA.
- Ambassadors must demonstrate a commitment to furthering their knowledge of the College of Agriculture, Life Sciences & Natural Resources and the University of Wyoming through their participation in College Ambassador activities.

Expectations

Ambassadors help promote the College of Agriculture, Life Sciences & Natural Resources in various ways. Activities include, but are not limited to:

- Prospective student recruitment; Acting as liaisons with the general public
- Retention of current students; Share student experiences with diverse audiences
- Acting as liaisons with the general public
- Participate in alumni and donor relation activities
- Participate in leadership classes and/or conferences

Ambassadors will be eligible to earn a stipend of up to \$500 for 30 hours of participation, per semester.

Application Requirements

- Submit the attached application form and a copy of your resume by 5:00 p.m. on Friday April
 12, 2024 for consideration. Your resume should include academic achievements, community
 service, campus activities, and leadership experience.
- Applicants will be reviewed by a panel and scheduled for an interview during the week of April 29- May 3, 2024. As a part of the interview, students are expected to have a basic knowledge of the University of Wyoming and the College of Agriculture, Life Sciences & Natural Resources. Students should prepare appropriately before interviewing with the selection committee.
