

## **General CME Information**

CME Credit is provided for select WIND ECHO networks and training opportunities. Currently, participants can earn CME credit by attending live UW ECHO in Rural Obstetrical Care sessions held monthly on Thursdays from 12-1 pm MT.

In order to receive CME credit, you must:

1. Attend the live ECHO session
2. Complete the post-session evaluation that will be emailed to you following the session
3. On that evaluation, you will be able to indicate if you would like to receive CME credit.

1 CME credit is provided by Cheyenne Regional Medical Center (CRMC) for each UW ECHO in Rural Obstetrical Care session. The evaluation will be open for 2 weeks following the live session. After 2 weeks, our team will email you the CME code to claim credit through CRMC, along with instructions for how to claim credit.


## **CME Accreditation Statement**




