The Partnership Access Line (PAL) is a telephone-based program funded by the Wyoming Department of Health, and affiliated with the University Of Washington School Of Medicine and Seattle Children's Hospital.

The PAL program provides a direct line of support to healthcare providers who have questions about the mental health care of their child and adolescent patients, such as diagnostic clarification, medication adjustment or treatment planning.

To consult with a psychiatrist about your patient, call 877-501-7257 Monday–Friday, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

The provider to provider consults are covered by HIPAA, section 45 CFR 164.506; no additional release of patient information is required to consult by phone.

This consultation team consists of child and adolescent psychiatrists and master's-level social worker who can assist with finding mental health resources for patients with any type of insurance (state-funded, private or no insurance).
