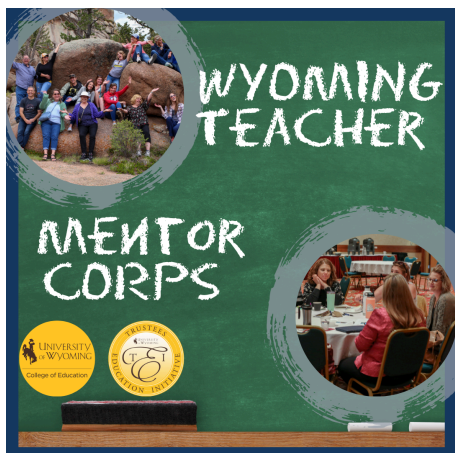

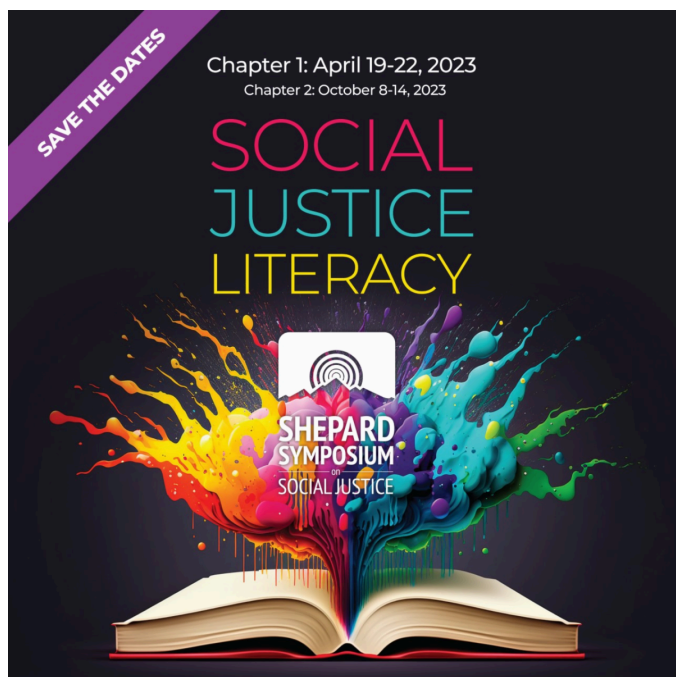


## Wyoming Innovations in Learning Conference Call for Proposals

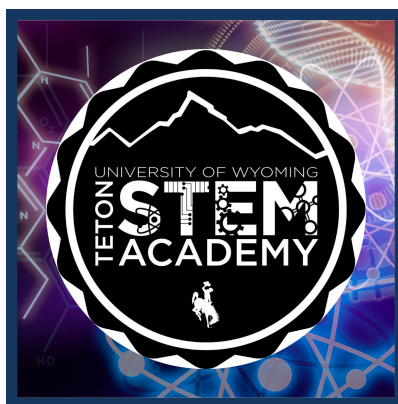
