New Year, New Leadership



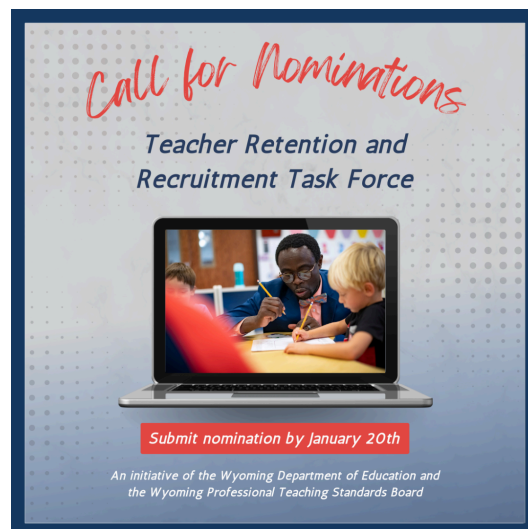

Teacher Retention and Recruitment Task Force

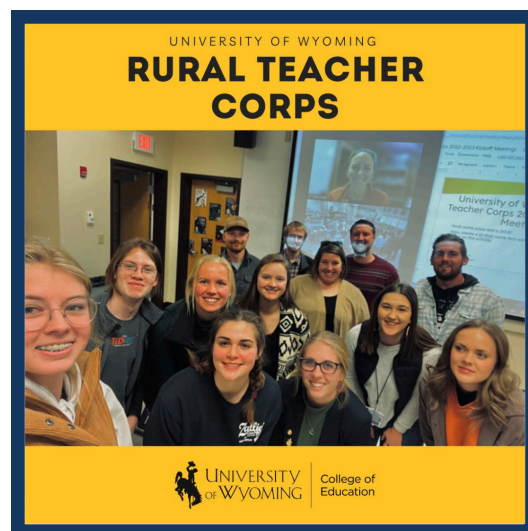
From January 9-20, 2023, the WDE and PTSB will begin [accepting applications](#) for stakeholders to participate. The task force will be composed of up to three district superintendents, three principals, 10 teachers, one parent, one teacher who has left the profession, one personnel director, one school counselor, and one post-secondary representative.

Those applying will need to be available for an initial in-person meeting on Saturday, February 11, 2023, in Casper, followed by monthly meetings held in-person on the second Saturday of the month through May. Additional virtual meetings will be scheduled as needed. Applicants will be notified of their selection status by February 1, 2023.



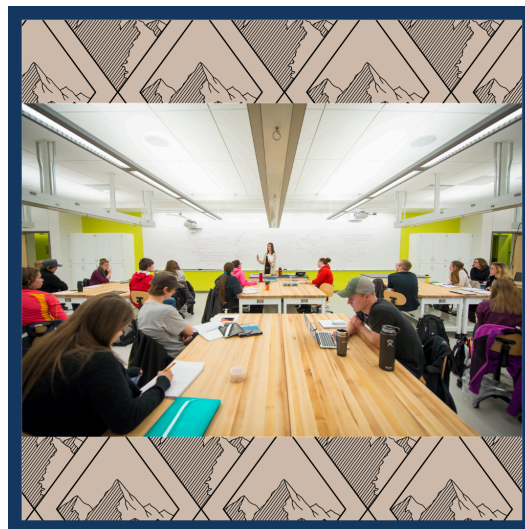
Rural Teacher Corps Update & Meeting

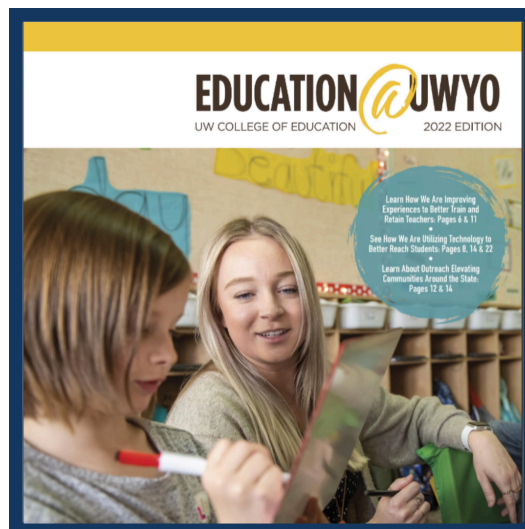
CoE Education Summit
