A calendar invitation was sent out on Monday, June 13th. If you are not able to attend please try to designate a liaison to attend on your behalf.

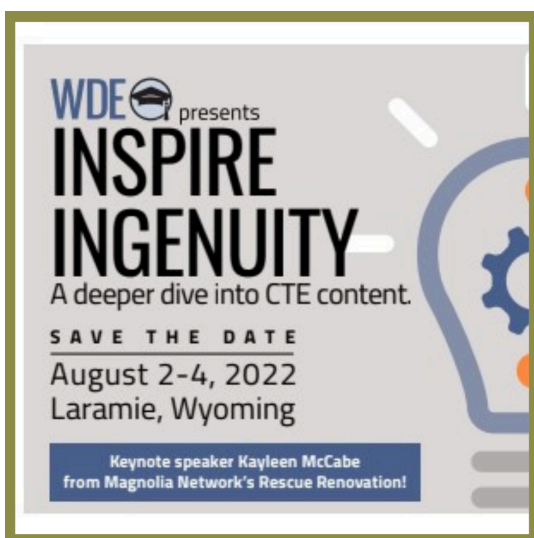
Education Community Updates

The 21 cohort members represent 16 of the state's 48 school districts -- creating a web of expert teacher mentors that spans Wyoming.

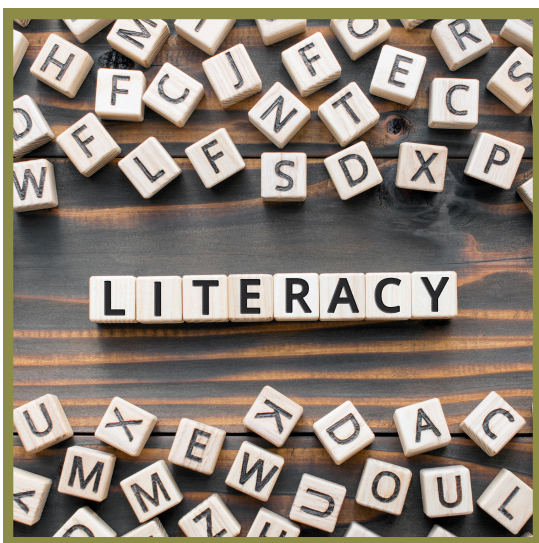
