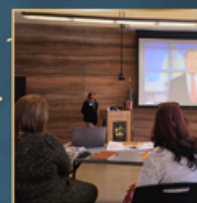
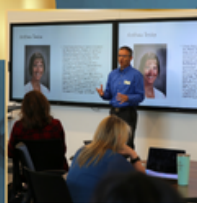

The Wyoming Education Association is continuing to capture stories surrounding how districts have used their ARP/ESSER monies in an effort to highlight the successes that districts have seen through projects which utilized these funds. The Wyoming Department of Education is seeking public comment on the proposed **Wyoming State Plan** for the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act (Perkins V). The act provides federal funding for secondary and postsecondary career and technical education in Wyoming. The 2023-2024 federal award to Wyoming is \$5.8 million. In order to continue to receive funds, Wyoming must submit a plan for Wyoming Career and Technical Education (CTE) for 2024-2028.

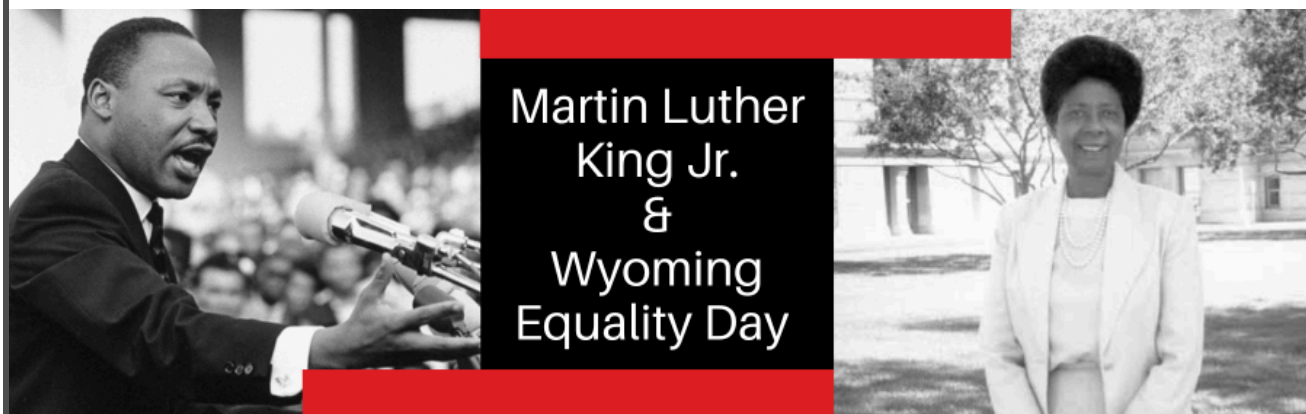


Supporting Educators to Improve Student Functional and Behavioral Outcomes
