July Strategic Planning Retreat and Meeting



This is a reminder that Nicholas has sent out WSUP membership invoices. Dues are requested by August 15, but if you wish to pay your dues before the end of the fiscal year, that will work as well. Dues predominantly fund the project coordinator salary who continues to oversee Partnership-specific initiatives, meetings, and budget. Dues also fund strategic partnership initiatives, outreach efforts, quarterly meetings, and more.

Please note the membership dues model has not changed for 2025-2026. That model is as follows:

- Districts: \$1000 base + \$1 per enrolled student in your district (cap of \$4000).




