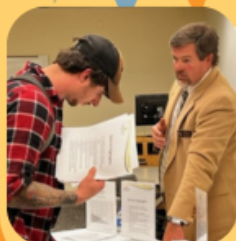

Free CTE Course for Wyoming High School Students

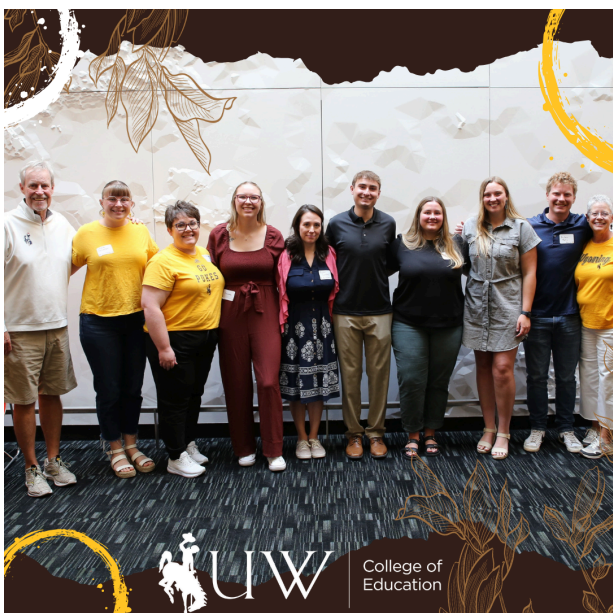
