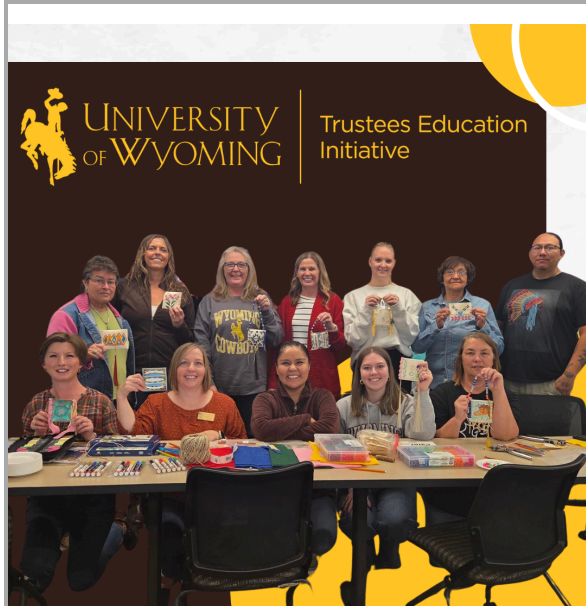


Mentor Corps Nominations for Cohort 5

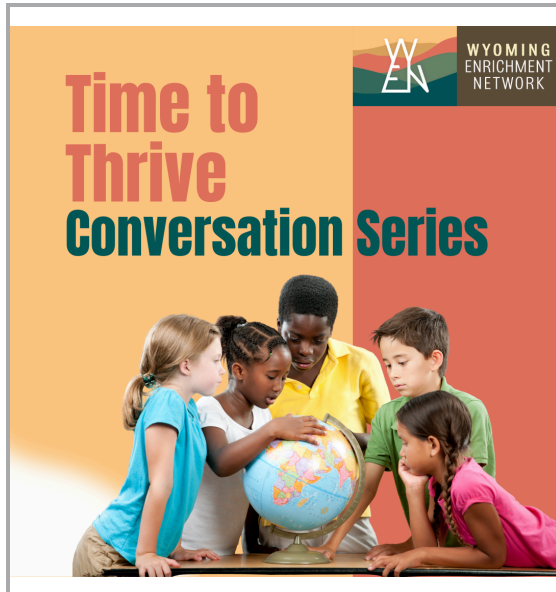
