

### Literacy Graduate Certificate

The University of Wyoming's Literacy Research Center and Clinic (LRCC) launched a pilot program inviting school districts to partner in supporting a cohort of teachers pursuing a Literacy Graduate Certificate beginning Fall 2025. The certificate program, approved by PTSB qualifies currently licensed teachers for the Wyoming Reading Endorsement at the K-6, 6-12, or K-12 levels.

As part of this pilot, the LRCC offered the Literacy endorsement opportunity to seven school districts located on or near the Wind River Reservation (Fremont Districts 1, 6, 14, 21, 24, 25, and 38). From this invitation a cohort was built consisting of 10 members - nine teachers from Lander Valley High and one teacher from Wind River Elementary. The program is funded through the LRCC.


