Background


- Population: 10,174 (2021)
- Rural and isolated community serving as the central hub for the Big Horn Basin (approximately 100-mile radius)
- 20% of Park County adults reported binge or heavy drinking
- 32% of driving related deaths in Park County had alcohol involvement
- Community physicians and providers expressed concern over alcohol abuse in the community

Literature Review

Excessive Drinking

Studies have shown that when screening and intervening for alcohol abuse, primary care physicians reported that patient access to health education materials and information about additional treatment resources are the most helpful tools for positive outcomes Online alcohol treatment has been shown to increase the number of sober days and decrease the mean drinks/day for patients struggling with alcoholism Rural locations have higher rates of alcohol abuse and harm compared to urban areas. The increased rate of alcohol abuse in rural locations compared to urban areas has been shown to be worsening over time

Community Partner and Deliverables



- Heart Mountain Free Clinic in Cody, Wyoming provides free healthcare to the uninsured and to those who fall 200% below the poverty line. Many patients they treat struggle with alcoholism
- A health education pamphlet was developed with information on local resources, online resources, 24-hour hotlines, tips for reducing alcohol intake, and health benefits of reducing alcohol intake

Next Steps

- **Details of Distribution Plan:**
 - Target audience includes members of the Cody community struggling with alcoholism
 - Distribute pamphlet file and printed pamphlets to Heart Mountain Free Clinic and Billings Clinic in Cody
- Printed pamphlets were distributed and well received by both Billings Clinic and Heart Mountain Free Clinic. Providers will distribute pamphlets to select patients
