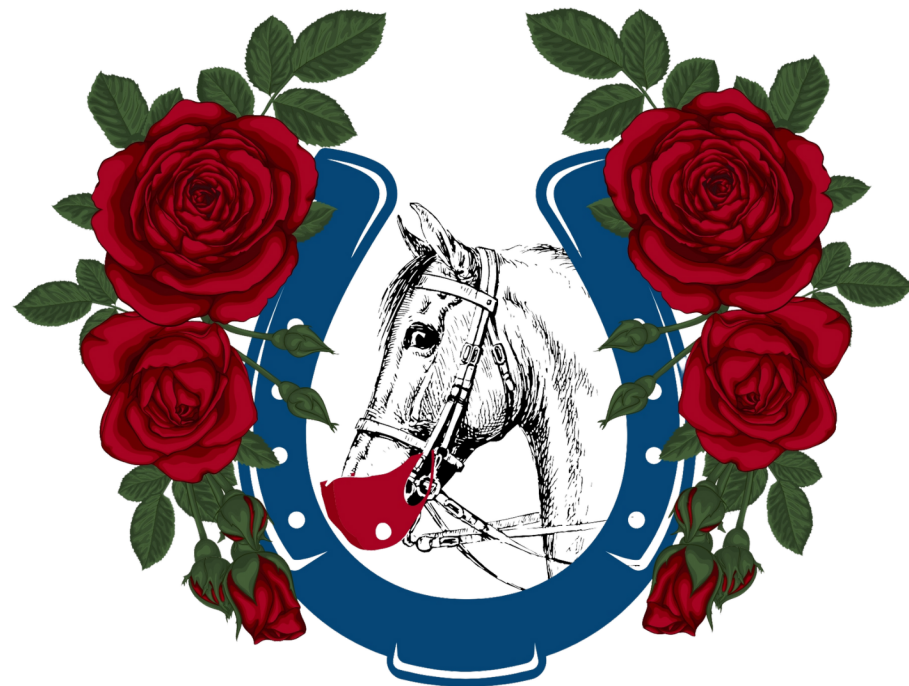
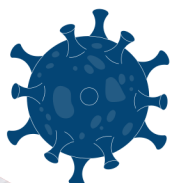


Conference Objectives
