

## REVISED HCM PHASED GO-LIVE APPROACH

## Greetings,

Over the past several weeks, the HCM Project Team has been working diligently on testing all the functionality of the HCM system and testing Payroll. Many of you have participated in this testing as well, and we are very thankful for your participation and feedback.

## Throughout this project, the HCM team has kept focus on two main goals:

- Payroll must be accurate, with correct deductions, accruals, benefits, and gross to net income.
- Users must have ample time to train and learn all the modules related to HCM so they are prepared when the system goes live.

In keeping with these goals and the overall project plan, the project team has further phased their go-live dates to allow for more time to test payroll, while going live with several modules that are ready to be released to campus. This phased go-live will also allow a phased approach to training. We will have trained on and completed the basic HCM training and the training for annual performance evaluations in our new Performance module prior to the release of Payroll. Once the performance evaluation season is complete, users can then spend time training on how to enter time and absences, which will be released to campus by April 15 with Payroll. Approximately 70% of Oracle HCM customers pursue a phased go-live approach as noted below.
