If you completed your required online training prior to 3 PM on Friday, January 19<sup>th</sup>, you can now access WyoCloud Planning and Budgeting through WyoWeb. To login, select the Planning and Budgeting link under the WyoCloud menu in Faculty & Staff Resources on WyoWeb.

Access for any user who has not completed training will be provisioned the business day following training completion.

### Tips and Tricks: Logging in for the First Time

When logging into WyoCloud Planning and Budgeting for the first time, there are two tasks you should complete to customize the system to fit your preferences:

- 1. Set your system preference by following this quick reference guide.
- 2. Set your user variables by following this <u>quick reference guide</u>.

In your role as a Planning and Budgeting user, your first task within this system is to prepare your FY18 forecast for your remaining funds. Forecasts are due to the Budget Office on the following dates:

- February 9th 5:00pm Non-Academic Affairs Units
- February 16th 5:00pm Academic Affairs Units

Please note that as you are completing your forecasts, only 5 months of FY18 actual expenditures have been loaded into WyoCloud Planning and Budgeting from WyoCloud Financial Management. There are also some IDTs and expenditures corrections are currently being processed and may not appear in WyoCloud Planning and Budgeting. Once the month of December is closed, we will upload December actuals into WyoCloud Planning and Budgeting and will notify you when we do so.
