Some integration in WyoCourses are automatically included in your course navigation. Other integrations can be optionally used in courses and can be placed in different places within the course to help accommodate your needs. Not all apps can be placed anywhere but the following sections should give you an idea where on can set up access to an integration in WyoCourses

Placing Integrations/Apps in the Navigation Menu

The apps that WyoCourses already support and that can be put into the navigation menu of your courses can be found in the course settings page in the navigation tab.
