

Wyoming Technology Transfer Center Work Zone and ATSSA Flagger Certification Program Policy

The Wyoming Technology Transfer Center (WYT2) has instructors certified by the American Traffic Safety Services Association (ATSSA) to teach Work Zone Safety and the ATSSA Flagger Certification Training Course. This program provides training to improve the safety of flaggers working on public roads and highways.

WYT2 will provide instructors who travel to the agency's location and perform the 8-hr Work Zone and ATSSA Flagger Training. Instructors also administer the certification exams and provide the certification cards.

To set up a Training:

- Agencies can request the training by calling our office at 307-766-6743 during normal business hours or emailing us at wyt2c@uwyo.edu.
- The base fee for the training will be \$1200.00. This fee covers travel expenses of the instructor(s), the required material for the course, and the certification of up to 12 people.
- Additional people are \$95/ea.
- Lunch is not provided; attendees will need to make own lunch arrangements.

To receive certification, participants must attend the full training and receive a passing score of 70% or better. The certificate will be valid for 3 years from the date of certification.

Participants are encouraged to refer to the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) and State and Local standards for the most current information. Standards vary by area and change periodically, so relying solely on this training is not encouraged.
