



Local Project Administration (LPA) Certification

Workshop Objective

Local Project Administration through WYDOT enables cities, towns and nonprofit agencies to make transportation improvements with federal and state money. A certified staff member takes charge of a “locally administered project” in partnership with WYDOT which makes sure all federal and state requirements are met. Requirements can be overwhelming to local agencies, especially if federal funds are infrequently used. The goal is to assist local agencies in bringing projects to successful completion.

Workshop Description

This one-day course offers guidance on the administrative, legal, financial, and environmental requirements for locally sponsored projects awarded federal and state transportation fund.

Who Should Attend

Any city, town, county, or local public agency employee or consultant project manager who will be responsible for the oversight of a federally funded project should attend this certification workshop. Attendees are expected to already possess a working knowledge of this subject.

Instructors

WYDOT and FHWA will provide instructors for this certification.
