Fellowships for graduate students

Dr. George E. Menkens Memorial Scholarship:

Ph.D. candidates in ecology, evolution, wildlife, or fisheries that have completed their prelims. Previous awardees are not eligible. Funds may be used for research support or one or more semesters of student stipend/tuition. To apply, submit a single pdf with a 2-page CV and a 5-page research proposal that includes Introduction, Objectives, Approach, and References Sections.

To apply for any of the following awards, submit a 1-page, single-spaced summary of graduate research and career goals (some awards have additional requirements, as indicated):

Vern Bressler Fisheries Scholarship

Z&P Graduate students studying fisheries biology and management, especially of cold-water fishes.

Jackson Hole One Fly- Dennis Anderson Memorial Scholarship

Z&P Graduate students focused on the biology and management of aquatic systems. Funds may be used for research support, equipment, and travel.

American Fisheries Society Ron Remmick Memorial Scholarship

Z&P Graduate students focused on the biology and management of aquatic systems. Membership in the student sub-unit of the American Fisheries Society is required.

Great Plains Fishery Worker's Association Scholarship

Z&P Graduate students conducting research in fisheries biology and management.

George T. Baxter Fellowship

Z&P graduate students, with preference given to studies of fish, aquatic invertebrates or amphibians.

Reed W. Fautin Memorial Graduate Scholarship

Z&P Graduate students with research focus on terrestrial ecology or wildlife management. Demonstrated scholastic excellence and career commitment are important.

Margaret and Sam Kelly Ornithology Research Fund

Graduate students studying hummingbirds, waterfowl, or sage grouse and their habitats, as well as wildlife diseases that affect wild bird populations.

L. Floyd Clark Graduate Scholar Award

Z&P Graduate students in the first two years of their program.

L. Floyd Clark Greater Yellowstone Award

Z&P Graduate students conducting research in the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem.

Michael and Linda Tierman Scholarship and Research Fund

Z&P Graduate students with research focus on wildlife and fisheries ecology and management.

Dennis Jespersen Memorial Scholarship (Wyoming Wildlife Federation)

Z&P Graduate students studying fisheries biology and management with a goal of establishing a career in Wyoming.

Women in Conservation Biology, Ecology and Education Fellowship Fund

Female graduate students with demonstrated excellence in conservation biology or ecology and/or ecology education and outreach. (jointly administered with Botany)

Reed W. Fautin Memorial Undergraduate Scholarship

Z&P undergraduate students with demonstrated scholastic excellent in terrestrial ecology/wildlife.

Great Plains Fishery Worker's Association Scholarship

Z&P undergraduate students conducting research in fisheries biology and management.

Vern Bressler Fisheries Undergraduate Scholarship

Z&P undergraduate students (junior or senior) who are Wyoming residents studying fisheries biology and management, especially of cold-water fishes.

American Fisheries Society Ron Remmick Memorial Scholarship

Z&P undergraduate students focused on the biology and management of aquatic systems.

Membership in the student sub-unit of the American Fisheries Society is required.

Robert A. Jenkins Undergraduate Research Award

Z&P undergraduate students of junior standing conducting research in genetics, molecular, cellular or developmental biology.
